Synopsis of the Messages

God lost something, and He wants it back. That's the theme from Genesis to Revelation. The Father created a bride for the Son. In Eden, that bride was seduced away by a deceiver. But the Son came into that Garden and vowed to fight to win back His precious bride. And that's what the whole Bible is: The story of the Son's fight to recapture His bride. When that battle is over, when every last person who will come back to the Son has come back, the Father will throw the biggest party ever - a wedding party. Way back in the Old Testament book of Isaiah, 700 years before Christ, God started talking about this party:

"On this mountain the LORD of hosts will make for all peoples a feast of rich food, a feast of well-aged wine, of rich food full of marrow, of aged wine well refined. And he will swallow up on this mountain the covering that is cast over all peoples, the veil that is spread over all nations. He will swallow up death forever; and the LORD GOD will wipe away tears from all faces, and the reproach of His people he will take away from all the earth, for the LORD has spoken. (25:6-8)

When this party happens, death is dead. Tears are gone. Sadness and mourning have no place at the table. It will be time to celebrate, because the search and rescue mission has been completed. People from every tribe and tongue and nation will party with God.

Fast-forward 700 years to Jesus. He talked a lot about this big party. Remember the parable of the Prodigal Son? Jesus ended that parable by describing a big party the father throws when the lost son comes home. It's an integral part of the story. Everything is headed toward a massive celebration. The story of the Bible ends with a party! All of human history is moving toward this one event – the wedding supper of the Lamb. Everything that stands in the way of that is being removed. It's the only thing that really matters to God the Father – the wedding supper for the Son and His bride. You can read about it in the closing chapters of Revelation, 21 and 22. It's an incredible place. It's a glorious new heavens and a new earth. There is no longer any darkness; no longer any death, no longer any mourning or crying or pain. There is no longer a terrifying sea; no longer a sun. The Lamb and His bride will light the place up!

The purpose of this series has been to show you the theological foundation for E.A.C.H. I hope you get it now. God lost something, and He wants it back. This is why we join the Son of God in the great mission of seeking and saving that which was lost. This is why we, the servants of the King, run out to the streets to invite anyone who will to come to the party He is throwing for His Son! This is the reason behind E.A.C.H. – because God wants every human being at this party. He desires for all to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth (1Timothy 2:4). He desires that none should perish, but that all should come home to Him (2Peter 3:9). GOD LOVES EVERY LOST PERSON ON THIS PLANET!

But, Paul asks, "How will they hear about Him, if no one tells them" (Romans 10:14)? This is our mandate. This is our mission. To live for what matters to our Bridegroom, Jesus. His bride. The Church. And the perfecting of His bride in preparation for that day. That's why E.A.C.H. matters so much. We're playing a role in the story of the ages, the greatest love story ever told.
