## **Synopsis of Armenian Message**

It's Mother's Day and a good example of a mother could be found in I Samuel chapter 1. Hannah was the wife of a man by the name of Elkanah. She was childless and in the culture of that day this was a stigma. Elkanah, had a second wife, Peninnah who had children and most likely he had married her because Hannah couldn't bear him any children. Hannah was a woman who endured a lot of pain because of her childlessness and also because of the Peninnah's taunting. But Hannah was a women of patience and prayer. Year after year she would go up to the Lord's temple to sacrifice and prayer to the Lord to give her children. She made a vow that if the Lord would give her a child she would dedicate the son to Him. When the Lord finally responded to her prayers and gave her a son, she kept her promise. When the boy was old enough she sent him to serve the Lord at the temple in Shiloh.

Friends, the example of Hannah as a woman of prayer, patience and promise is a good example to all of us.
