Synopsis of Armenian Message

John's first purpose in writing stated in chapter one was, "to make our joy complete" (1:4). In this chapter he gives us the second purpose, "My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin" (2:1). Yet knowing that as fallen, sinful humans we will sin, he adds that if we sin we need to remember that, "we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense – Jesus Christ, the Righteous One." This is so because Jesus has made atonement (paid for) our sin. We can be sure of this if we know Jesus personally and obey His commands. The test for knowing Jesus is walking in His steps, "whoever claims to live in him must walk as Jesus did" (2:6). Now the practical outworking of this relationship with Jesus is displayed in our relationship with others. Our loving or hating of our brothers and sisters shows weather we are walking in the light or in darkness (2:8-10).

Friends, our talk needs to be backed-up by our walk. How are you doing on obeying God's commands? How are you doing in the area of loving each other?
