Synopsis of Armenian Message

The apostle John in these verses mentions more reasons for writing. He writes because, "their sins are forgiven, they know him from the beginning, they have overcome the evil one, they have God's Word abiding in them, and they are strong in the faith." In verses 15-17, John adds a warning against the love of the world and its false attractions. The word "world" here and in scripture in general is usually used to mean human society that is organized around secular human principles that leaves no place for God. So john says, "If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. The simple reason for this is that the love of the world is in compatible with the love of the Father. The world and its attractions cater to man's "cravings of sinful desires," the "lust of the eyes," and the "boasting of what he has and does." John adds a reminder that this world with all its desires and attractions is passing away, but God and what He offers is eternal.

Friends, we will be wise to consider these words and evaluate our lives in their light. How in love are you with what this world is offering? How much do you love God the Father? Does your life show that you love the Father more than the world?
