Synopsis of Armenian Message

In these verses, the apostle John addresses the question, "How are those who are called 'children of God' known?" First, the title of 'children of God' is the privilege of those who because of God's great love shown through the sacrifice of His Son Jesus belong to Him. Then Paul mentions few characteristics that should distinguish the children of God: (1) Because Jesus is righteous those who are born of him will also be know for doing what is right. (2) The world (secular humanistic society) does not recognize the children of God because it does not know God. (3) Those who belong to Jesus live with the hope of seeing Him. (4) No one who is born of God will continue to sin because the "seed" of the new life is in him.
