### Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In this passage Paul appeals to the believers in Corinth and cautions them not to receive "God's Grace in vein". What Paul is telling these believers is this: You who came to know God through faith in Jesus Christ and who have received the gift of salvation are not rejoicing in Christ. For you have received God's gift of reconciliation but now you carelessly sit idle in your lives not concerning yourselves to take part in the ministry of spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ to others. What Paul is saving is this: when it comes to evangelism there is no room for procrastination, "Today is the time of God's favor now is the day of salvation". This is why Paul is urging the believers in Corinth to use every opportunity to share their faith with others and rejoice while doing God's work. Paul also cautions them not to provoke opposition while sharing the gospel with none Christians but rather present themselves as servants of God. Paul encourages them to demonstrate a Christian conduct by enduring all hardships for the advancement of the gospel of Jesus Christ and by displaying the fruits of the Spirit in their lives in order to gain souls for Jesus.
