## Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In this section of his letter, the Apostle John almost repeats what he has already said in verses 7-12. Yet, when we read carefully we find him stressing three things: abiding, testifying, and being perfect. First, he says that we know that we are saved if we **abide** in Him and He in us through His Spirit. Second, he says the we know that we abide in Him because we "**testify** that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world." This testimony is not empty words but is backed by love. Third, he says, that when we truly manifest the love of God in our lives we will be displaying God's perfect love. In this world we will never know perfect love until Jesus finally appears and we are made like Him. For now we do our best through the power of the Holy Spirit to show the love of God who abides in us.

Friends, this love that John is talking about is a practical love. It is a love that reaches out to others, It is love that serves others and testifies to them of Jesus. Is there someone in your life that you need to love with your words and deeds today?
