Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In this section we come to John's concluding remarks of his letter. First he gives us a very clear purpose as to why he wrote this letter, "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life." This verse also teaches assurance of salvation, a very precious truth. This assurance comes through the Word of God. Next, John says that we can have confidence in prayer. When we are sure of our salvation, and as we learn God's will from His Word, "we can ask God for anything according to his will, he hears us." "That doesn't mean we can ask for whatever we want, but only what God wants for us, because what he wants is true and holy and good" (SU). John adds one last thing, we should watch-out for one another. If we see a fellow Christian brother or sister engaged in a sinful activity we are to pray for them.

Dear friends, as believers who have full assurance of salvation, and who have full confidence in God who hears our prayers, let us also watchout for one another so that we can help each other stay in the path of righteousness and love.
