### Synopsis of Armenian Message

Luke in this passage records to us the words that Mary uttered while visiting her cousin Elizabeth. Mary's song is similar to Old Testament psalms in that it is a hymn of praise for God's kindness. It is a song of pure joy, for Mary had found great reason to lift her voice in praise to God in spite of adverse circumstances. There were many unanswered questions (29-35), and her position in the society of the day was very uncomfortable, but Mary still revealed a heart of praise. She praised God for what He had done. She is joyful because God's promises are being fulfilled through her. Mary calls God her Savior. She seems to have a proper understanding of her position and place. She is joyful and filled with praise because of four divine qualities that she sees in God. (1), In verses 49-53, God is the Mighty One who has done great things. He has scattered and brought down the proud, but lifted up the humble. He has sent the rich away empty, but has filled the hungry with good things. (2), In verse 49b, God is Holy. Holiness communicates ideas of sincerity, purity, and singleness of purpose. (3), In verse 50, God is merciful towards those who fear Him. God is compassionate and desires to help. (4), In verses 54-55, God is Faithful. Mary rejoiced because God was keeping His promise. Mary's song of joy is the result of her realization that God's promise demonstrated that He had not forgotten Israel. God has never failed His people, nor will He ever fail them. His record of faithfulness is perfect.

Friends, no matter what your circumstances are like these days, remember that what God was accomplishing through Mary was for you and me. So, rise up, let God's Spirit lift you up, put your faith and confidence in God and sing a song of praise that shows that you have learned to believe God and trust Him in all things.
