## Synopsis of The Armenian Sermon

There are two kinds of people in the world: pillars and pillows. Those who lift up and those who lean. Those who support and those who are supported. The pillars play an important role. Without them structures collapse. They are the one that carry the burden without complaining.

The pillows have to be supported. They cannot stand alone. They must lean against something or somebody. Left to themselves, they fall flat. Writing to the church of Philadelphia, Asia Minor, Apostle John, urges its members to be pillars of the church. That challenge is for all Christians.

What are the characteristics of pillars in the church?

- 1. First, Pillars stand firm and are dependable. You can count on them in rain or shine. The pillars support the church on Sundays as well as during week days. They bear the stress and the strain of the building. They endure. They impress us with their firmness and assurance of stability.
- 2. Second, Pillars of the church manage to stand firm even when the church shows signs of weakness. They are loyal and faithful in spite of the obvious frailties of the church. Their love and loyalty is not conditional.
- **3.** Third, Pillars standing firm and experience inner strength. They are like those trees "planted beside streams of living water." They are positive and grateful people. They stand firm and grow.

All of us, regardless of our age and status, are called to be pillars and serve the Lord and His Church according to our ability.
